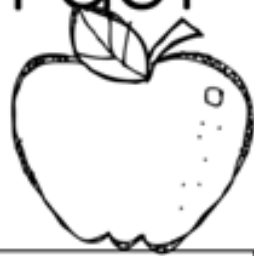


August Spelling Contract

Your goal is to earn at least 20 points. Some activities are worth 5 points while some activities are worth 10 points and might take 2 days.

Wed, Thu, & Fri: Choose activities to complete.

Five Point Activities

Scrambled Words Have an adult scramble up your words, and then try to put the letters in their correct order. Example: nekrnm marker	Other Handed If you are right handed, write your words with your left hand. If you are left handed, write your words with your right hand!	Test Me Have an adult, babysitter, or older sibling give you a spelling test. Then carefully grade your answers.
Back to School Scene Draw a picture of a back to school scene and hide your spelling words in your drawing! Don't forget to make it colorful and detailed!	Time's Up! Set a timer for three minutes. See how many times you can write your words before the timer goes off. Repeat three times.	Word Sort Find a way to sort your words. You can sort your words by spelling pattern, number of letters, number of vowels, etc. You must use all your spelling words.
Least to Greatest Write your words in order from least to greatest. Begin with the word that has the fewest letters and end with the word that has the most. If some of your words have the same number of letters, write them down in ABC order.	Handwriting Hero Words Write each of your spelling words in your neatest handwriting.	Snap and Clap Begin by saying your spelling word aloud. Then spell it out aloud letter by letter. When you say a consonant clap and when you say a vowel snap. Once you've finished spelling the word, say it aloud again. Parent Signature Required _____

Ten Point Activities

Guide Words First write each of your spelling words on a piece of paper. Then look up each word in the dictionary. After you find your spelling word, write down the two guide words at the top of the page next to the spelling word you just looked up. Repeat for all your words.	Commercial Spelling Use your spelling words to write TV or radio commercials for products you have invented in your mind! You can use all of your words in one commercial, as long as it makes sense. Or you may write multiple commercials until all of your words have been used.
Crossword Spelling Create a crossword using each of your spelling words. Include across and down clues for each of your words.	Superhero Spelling Use your spelling words to write letters to your favorite superhero! You can write one letter using all of your words, as long as your letter makes sense. Or you can write multiple letters using some of your words until you have used all of your spelling words in a superhero letter.
